Three years ago NSW had a serious problem. Slow economic growth, higher unemployment rates, increased debt, and increased taxes were putting the community under pressure.

The local community in Davidson will benefit from a range of state wide initiatives including a record \$61.5 billion for transport infrastructure, as well as major investments in health, education and supporting the most vulnerable in our state.

Mike Baird's Liberal Team is making Davidson a stronger and better community for all

- **Investing in Health** - \$54.1 million towards construction of the new Northern Beaches Hospital and new community health centre facilities; \$28.9 million to continue works at Royal North Shore Hospital and \$56.4 million for works at Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital.
- **Building our Roads** - \$400 million for road projects required for the Northern Beaches Hospital and millions for the NorthConnex Motorway M1-M2 link.
- **Improving Transport** - \$61 million to improve train stations through deep cleans, better security, painting, and new seats and lighting, and \$91 million to purchase 199 new buses.
- **Expanding our Police Force** - \$153 million to hire extra state-wide frontline police officers.
- **Investing in Education** - Over \$2 billion for Sydney Metropolitan Government schools.
- **Supporting the Vulnerable** - over \$6.5 million allocated to expand and improve accommodation for people with disability.
